

Word Study (8R11) (Instructions for Appleworks)

Task: In preparation for reading and discussing a passage of text, identify and define important words for your group.

Step One: Open the template file. Follow your teacher's instructions.

Step 2: Type the information required in each cell. To enter text in a cell, double click the cell, then type the text.

Step 3: Save the file using a different file name. To do this, select **File >> Save As**. Save the file in a location as directed by your teacher.

Step 4: Print a copy of your work in preparation for your group discussion of the passage.
