Task: Type your reading response and save it into the file. Remember to include your thoughts and feelings about the text as well as connections to other texts, your own experiences, your predictions, and any questions that you have about the text.

Step 1: Open the template file. Your teacher will tell you where it is saved.

Step 2: Create a new record (select **Ctrl + R**).

Step 3: Click on each field and type in the applicable information.
